A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 21-1 of Title 2, unless there is 20 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 2.1 This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Garden 22 and Egg Exchange Health Cooperative Act of 2015". 23 В. Owners of private land may enter into an agreement with the

Oklahoma Tax Commission so that privately owned land may be utilized

as community gardens under such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between the land owners and the Oklahoma Tax Commission. Private lands utilized as community gardens under this section shall be used for the production of fresh food, chicken eggs, herbs, fruits, flowers or vegetables for local consumption and distribution to charity, provided that production is not for the purpose of commercial endeavors. Private landowners entering into agreement with the Commission shall provide location and description of the parcels of land, contact information and any other information the Commission requires.

- C. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall develop an online website to list the location and availability of both public and private land to be utilized as community gardens as well as an application process on the Tax Commission's website. Through the website, community groups and individuals may apply to reserve available public and private land for community gardening, free of charge. The applicant shall submit the following information to the Tax Commission in accordance with the online application process:
 - 1. Any identifying name of the individual or group;
 - 2. The not-for-profit status of the group, if applicable;
 - 3. The name of a contact person for the group;
- 4. A legal mailing address and phone number for the contact person;

5. E-mail address and social security number of the contact person;

- 6. Name and contact information for the property owner if the land to be used is private vacant land;
 - 7. A legal description of the proposed garden site; and
 - 8. Description of the condition of the proposed garden site.
- D. Applicants shall submit a plan for the use of this land and agree to maintain the land in a condition consistent with the land-use plan. The land-use plans may include waste and gardening equipment disposal conditions. Landowners may pursue damages for misuse and violation of land-use agreements.
- E. The duration of the reservation to use land for gardening purposes shall be no less than one (1) year and no longer than three (3) years.
- F. No permanent structures shall be erected upon approved public lands in association with conducting gardening activities, including but not limited to permanent dwellings for chickens.

 Permission to construct permanent structures for gardening activities on private vacant land may be granted by the landowner.
- G. Gardens that contain both a garden and a chicken and egg cooperative must contain at least one (1) acre for every twelve laying hens and enough shelter to adequately and humanely protect the laying hens, unless otherwise prohibited by existing statute, ordinance or municipal code.

- H. The State of Oklahoma and any private landowner who makes land available for gardening shall not be liable for any accident or injury resulting from any community gardening activity during the time the land is reserved for community gardening.

 T. For purposes of this section. "community group" means any
- I. For purposes of this section, "community group" means any group of people consisting of more than one person who are residents of Oklahoma.
- J. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate all necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this section.

 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
