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requiring the reduction or withholding of State Aid funds for certain purposes; authorizing the State Board of Education to request certain transfer of funds; providing for certain proportional reduction of funds; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budgeting procedures; prohibiting certain budgeting procedures; and providing an effective date.

        SECTION 23. The funds allocated in Section 15 of this act for

    Financial Literacy shall be used to implement the provisions of

    Section 11-103.6h of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
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Early Intervention shall be transferred to the fund designated within the Office of Management and Enterprise Services as the Early Intervention Fund 250. It is the intent of the Legislature that funding available for SoonerStart Early Intervention Services be expended for direct services to eligible infants, toddlers and their families. The State Department of Education shall not contract, pay or reimburse for administrative cost recovery personnel, accounting, and management information system costs, maintenance and operations at the state or local level or indirect costs which do not comply with the requirements of Section 13-125 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

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SECTION 25. The funds allocated in Section 15 of this act for the Early Childhood Initiative shall be expended for the purpose of funding the early childhood program pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-105.4 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 26. The funds allocated in Section 15 of this act for the Parent Training Program, as authorized in Section 10-105.3 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be expended for the continuation and expansion of the Oklahoma Parents as Teachers Program.

SECTION 27. The funds allocated for the Rural Infant
Stimulation Environment (RISE) Program in Section 15 of this act
shall be used for capital expenditures and operations for a school

designed to serve children with disabilities from birth to five (5) years of age.

SECTION 28. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Department of Education by law shall be set by the State Board of Education. The State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 29. State Aid funds shall be reduced or withheld by the State Board of Education in an amount necessary to ensure compliance with the provisions of this act.

SECTION 30. The State Board of Education is authorized to request the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to transfer appropriated funds to the appropriate dispensing fund.

SECTION 31. If funds appropriated in this act are not sufficient to fully fund the provisions of this act, each school district which qualifies for funds, excluding Financial Support of

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Public Schools, pursuant to the provisions of this act shall take a
proportionate reduction.
    SECTION 32. Appropriations made by this act, not including
appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be
budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).
Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,
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2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
