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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 10-107, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 10-107. A. Except for the purposes of inquiry, the
18	council and its members shall deal with the administrative service
19	of the city solely through the city manager. The council and its
20	members may not:
21	1. Direct or request the city manager or other authority to
22	appoint or remove officers or employees;
23	2. Participate in any manner in the appointment or removal of
24	officers and employees of the city, except as provided by law; or

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3. Give orders on ordinary administrative matters to any subordinate of the city manager either publicly or privately.

B. Any member of a city council who violates the provisions of this section may be removed from office by an order of the district court in which the situs of the municipality is located as authorized by Section 8-107 of this title upon a finding by the court that the member in violation acted with gross negligence or in bad faith or with malice. The removal action may be brought by another member of the city council or the city manager. Municipal funds shall not be used to prosecute or defend such violations.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
