9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma School of Science and  
11 Mathematics; making an appropriation to the Board of  
12 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and  
13 Mathematics; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in  
14 certain categories and amounts; providing for duties  
15 and compensation of employees; providing budgetary  
16 limitations; requiring budgeting of certain funds in  
17 certain years; providing lapse dates; requiring  
18 certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget  
19 procedures; and providing an effective date.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of  
24 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any  
monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of  
the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum  
of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be  
necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma School of  
Science and Mathematics by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the  
 2 Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall budget all funds in  
 3 the following categories and amounts:

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 15 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be  
 16 set by the Director. The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics  
 17 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the  
 18 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
 19 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
 20 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
 21 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be  
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).  
5 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
6 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds  
7 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall  
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June  
10 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse  
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay  
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after  
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
17 from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been  
18 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
