12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, "per-pupil
17	expenditure" shall mean the aggregate current expenditures of school
18	districts, from all funding sources including federal funds, state
19	funds and local funds, plus the direct support aggregate current
20	expenditures of the state for the day-to-day operations of schools
21	and school districts from all funding sources including federal
22	funds, divided by the aggregate student membership number for the
23	same fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined. The
24	aggregate student membership number shall be the count of students

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1	enrolled on October 1 or the school day closest to October 1 to whom
2	school districts in the state provide a public education. The
3	aggregate current expenditures shall include without limitation the
4	following categories of expenditures:
5	1. Instruction;
6	2. Support services for students;
7	3. Support services for instructional staff;
8	4. Support services for general administration;
9	5. Support services for school administration;
10	6. Support services for business;
11	7. Operation and maintenance of plant services;
12	8. Student transportation services;
13	9. Child nutrition services; and
14	10. Enterprise services.
15	B. Aggregate current expenditures shall not include
16	expenditures for adult and community education, facilities
17	acquisition and construction services, debt services, property and
18	other expenditures not related to the day-to-day operations.
19	C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
20	when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational and
21	governmental entities. When reporting or publishing the per-pupil
22	expenditure for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall
23	also report or publish each category of expenditure as listed in
24	subsection A of this section as well as the aggregate expenditure.

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1	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
