10	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs; making an appropriation; stating
11	purpose; providing for duties and compensation of
12	employees; requiring compliance with and providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates;
13	requiring and prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing an effective date.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
18	Department of Veterans Affairs from any monies not otherwise
19	appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
20	the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of
21	(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
22	imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law.
23	SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
24	otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs by law shall be set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans 2 3 Affairs. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal 4 year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the following 5 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special 6 7 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of 8 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

11 SECTION 3. Appropriations made by this act, not including 12 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be 14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17). 15 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30, 16 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds 17 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall 18 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 19 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June 20 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse 21 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 22 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 23 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay 24 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after

3	from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
4	approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
5	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
