7	An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8	2011, Section 1135.2, as last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1135.2), which relates to specialty license plates;
9	deleting certain plate; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 15,
10	Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 13, 1135.5), which relates to support and assistance
11	specialty license plates; creating the Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Specialty License Plate;
12	providing for design; authorizing licensing agreement; specifying fees; specifying apportionment
13	of fees; and providing an effective date.
14	
15	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
18	last amended by Section 12, Chapter 54, O.S.L. 2015 (47 O.S. Supp.
19	2018, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
21	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
22	plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
23	provided by this section.
24	

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 8 9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 12 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 13 amateur radio operator license plates.

14 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 15 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 16 applications for special license plates authorized under this 17 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 23 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as 4 follows:

5 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 6 7 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 8 9 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 10 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 11 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 12 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 14 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 15 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be 21 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National 22 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide 23 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be 24 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

6 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates 7 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of 8 9 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air 10 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to 11 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have 12 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. 13 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present 14 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services 15 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form 16 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates 17 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but 18 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such 20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been 21 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply 22 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each 23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 24 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 6 7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 8 9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 12

13 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 15 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 16 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 17 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 18 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 19 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 20 The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been less. 21 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 22 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 23 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The

1 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
2 provided by this section for special license plates;

8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
 7, 1941,
- b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 13 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 14 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
19 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
20 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
21 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
 of 1945,
- 24

- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 3

c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 8 9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 11 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 13 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 14 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 15 registration after the initial issue;

16 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the 18 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 19 the United States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
 1944,
- b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
 participation cannot be verified by the United States

Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its discretion, accept evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license plate, and c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 11 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 12 13 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 14 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 15 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 16 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 17 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 18 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 19 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
 24 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were

1 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply 2 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed during a war and that the person making 3 4 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent 5 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one 6 7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 8 9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 12 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 13 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 14 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 15 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 16 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
21 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;
23 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be

24 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal

1 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 2 3 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 4 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 5 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 6 7 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common education police department by either an identification card or 8 9 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 10 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 11 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 12 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of 13 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in 14 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 15 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 16 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 17 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 18 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 19 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 20 21 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 22 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 23 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from 24 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may

apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, 6 7 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate 8 9 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 10 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 11 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words 12 "WORLD WAR II";

13 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of 17 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having 18 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June 19 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former 20 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for 21 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold

1 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
2 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
3 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
4 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
5 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
6 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

7 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
9 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
10 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
11 be produced upon application;

Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 12 19. 13 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 14 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 15 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 16 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 17 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 18 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 19 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and 20 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the 21 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red 22 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design 23 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other

24

than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

10 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 11 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 12 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and 13 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert 14 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 22. 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates 17 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present 18 member of a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such 19 persons may apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each 20 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 21 23. 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License 22 Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or 23 survivor of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal 24 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

24. 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

7 25. 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons
9 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in the
10 Ninety-Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
11 with the Ninety-Nines;

12 26. 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates 13 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman 14 Badge. The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the 15 legend shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. 16 Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat 17 Infantryman Badge". Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman 18 Badge license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 19 of one (1) ton or less;

20 <u>27. 26.</u> Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates 21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present 22 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the 23 United Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia

Combat Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

28. <u>27.</u> Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

8 29. 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such 9 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 10 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the 11 United States Secretary of Defense;

12 30. 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission 14 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 15 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 16 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 17 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying 18 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 31. 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be 20 designed for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall 21 designate the house of the Legislature in which the legislator 22 serves and the district number;

23 <u>32.</u> <u>31.</u> Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
 24 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United

1 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 2 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 3 4 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been 5 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the 6 7 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 8 9 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license 10 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no 11 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying 12 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any 13 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or 14 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or 15 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 16 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 17 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The 19 fee provided by this section for the special license plate 20 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 21 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 22 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 23 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

24

1 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate 2 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be 3 4 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also 5 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 6 7 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 8 9 the Tax Commission;

10 33. 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates -11 such plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air 12 Force Association. Persons applying for such license plate must 13 show proof of membership in the Association. The license plates 14 shall be designed in consultation with the Association;

15 34. 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such 16 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 17 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons 18 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 21 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 22 Academy;

23 <u>35. 34.</u> Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid

1 operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a 2 motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been 3 4 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. 5 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 6 7 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax 8 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have 9 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call 10 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications 11 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on 12 13 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for 14 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee 15 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other 16 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant 17 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license 18 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio 19 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall 20 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any 21 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The 22 right to such special identification plates herein provided for 23 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the 24 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

36. 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
 Oklahoma;

6 37. 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 7 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for 8 9 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or 10 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county 11 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 12 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which 13 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 14 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 15 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 16 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 17 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 18 state;

19 38. <u>37.</u> Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
21 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
22 shall mean:

a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
United States Armed Forces or as a member of the

1 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result of the performance of duties for any branch of the United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard while on active military duty, or

5 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces or as a member of the 6 7 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of injury, illness or disease caused by the performance 8 9 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death 10 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable 11 discharge of such person.

12 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 13 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 14 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 15 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

16 39. 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such 17 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 18 who has been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United 19 States Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea 20 Defense Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated 21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 40. 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be 23 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry. 24 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
