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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
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	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of			
19	Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the			
20	General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year			
21	ending June 30, 2016, the sum of Dollars (\$0.00) or so			
22	much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon			
23	the Department of Corrections by law.			
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SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the Director of the Department of Corrections. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant

to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with state agencies to utilize prison inmates for construction projects subject to written restrictions and conditions regarding security classification and other matters related to the control of inmates and public safety. Before utilizing inmates, the Department of Corrections shall enter into a written agreement concerning, but not limited to, liability, funding, pay, public security and transportation. Prison inmates shall not be used to replace any current state agency employees.

SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17). Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse

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    to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
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    These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
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    simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay
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    obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after
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    the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
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    and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
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    from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
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    approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
        SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
