13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-7-116 of Title 10A, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. When a child in the custody of the Department of Human
17	Services becomes eligible for adoption and the child needs a
18	permanent placement, the Department shall notify and disseminate
19	information about the child to licensed child-placing agencies that
20	have requested in writing to receive such notice in order to locate
21	a possible prospective adoptive parent for the child.
22	B. Upon completion of an adoption specified in subsection A of

this section, the Department may provide reimbursement of expenses
