9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal  
11 Investigations; making an appropriation; stating  
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
13 and amounts; providing for the duties and  
14 compensation of employees; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; making certain full-time-equivalent  
16 employees contingent upon certain funding; providing  
17 lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget  
18 practices; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of  
19 Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise  
20 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
22 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
23 imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Board  
 2 of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the  
 3 following categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 13 upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by  
 14 the Chief Medical Examiner of the Board of Medicolegal  
 15 Investigations. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the  
 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the following  
 17 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
 18 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
 19 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
 20 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be  
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).  
5 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
6 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds  
7 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall  
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June  
10 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse  
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay  
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after  
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
17 from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been  
18 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
