9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney
11 General; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 authorizing transfer of certain funds; requiring
13 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 providing budgetary limitations; providing lapse
16 dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget
17 procedures; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
20 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
21 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2016, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
23 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
24 the Office of the Attorney General by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

1 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
2 ending June 30, 2016, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) to
3 transfer to the Legal Services Revolving Fund created pursuant to
4 subsection G of Section 921.1 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Office
6 of the Attorney General is authorized to transfer an amount not to
7 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) from the Office of the
8 Attorney General's Evidence Fund (700 Fund), created by Section 19
9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes to the Office of the Attorney
10 General's Revolving Fund (200 Fund) created by Section 20 of Title
11 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the Office
13 of the Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following
14 categories and amounts:

4 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the
7 Office of the Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General
8 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the
9 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
10 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
11 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
12 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

16 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
8 from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been
9 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

10 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
