11	An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last amended by
12	Sections 14 and 16 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature,
13	which relate to specialty license plates; modifying who may apply for Ducks Unlimited License Plates;
14	reauthorizing issuance of license plate to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Original State
15	Flag; authorizing use of combination of numbers and letters up to certain number; providing for issuance
16	of license plate to demonstrate support for 911
17	dispatchers; providing for issuance of license plate demonstrating support for the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame; providing for design of license plate;
18	authorizing certain licensing agreement; providing
19	for issuance of license plate to demonstrate support for certain association; prescribing process for
20	design of license plate; authorizing certain agreement; authorizing maximum payment per license
21	plate issued; providing for distribution of certain proceeds; and providing an effective date.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as 3 last amended by Section 14 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the 4 lst Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as 5 follows:

6 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby 7 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license 8 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or 9 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other 10 subject as provided by this section.

11 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 12 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 13 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 14 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 15 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

23 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 24 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept

1 applications for special license plates authorized under this The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 2 section. eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 3 4 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 5 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 6 7 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 8 9 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

11 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 12 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 13 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 14 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 15 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 16 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 17 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 18 removed from the vehicle.

Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective

1 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null 2 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are 3 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 4 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

5 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as6 follows:

Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
round and square dancing;

National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
Association;

4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for

a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
 contain the Masonic emblem;

5 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License 6 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for 7 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be 8 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's 9 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in 10 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall 11 contain the Shriner's emblem;

Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
ballooning in this state;

15 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall 16 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member 17 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an 18 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a 19 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an 20 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an 21 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate 22 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate 23 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star 24 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

1 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of 3 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of 4 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 5 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights 6 7 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the 8 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation 9 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of 10 Columbus emblem;

9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

15 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
17 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
18 membership in persons wishing to demonstrate support for Ducks
19 Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with Ducks Unlimited;

21 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
23 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in

Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
 consultation with Kiwanis International;

3 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates 4 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a 5 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated 6 7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a 8 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed 9 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public 10 Accountants;

11 Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates 13. 12 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate 13 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons 14 applying for such license plate must show proof of official 15 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment, 16 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or 17 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state 18 emergency management department head;

19 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
23 Conservation Corps;

1 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and 2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license 3 4 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton 5 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate 6 7 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian 8 9 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

10 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall be 11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, 12 by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued to any 13 resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent Protective 14 Order of Elks;

15 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for 17 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued 18 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to 19 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate 20 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

21 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
22 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
23 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
24 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply

1 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof 2 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be 3 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from 4 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
consultation with American Business Clubs;

10 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates 11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 12 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States 13 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall 14 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central 15 Oklahoma;

Unless otherwise 17 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows: 18 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be 19 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be 20 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and 21 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the 22 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in 23 Section 1104 of this title.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as 2 last amended by Section 16 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the 3 lst Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as 4 follows:

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
financial assistance as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used 12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been 13 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary information directly into such system and generate a receipt 3 4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 6 7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 16 removed from the vehicle.

For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are

not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as 4 follows:

University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 11 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in 13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide 15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to 16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such 17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination 18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for 19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued 20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated 21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee 22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by 23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned 2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed 4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid. 5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a 6 7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an 8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department. 9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to 11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any 12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may 13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated 14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon 15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire 16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief 17 of the fire department.

Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue. Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for

motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

7 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
8 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
9 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
10 Living Memorial;

11 Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be 4. 12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax 13 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in 14 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any 15 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in 16 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in 17 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may 18 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license 19 plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
 the prevention of child abuse.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected6 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to 8 9 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The 10 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers 11 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized 12 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States 13 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if 14 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United 15 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be 16 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or 17 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not 18 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate 19 issued:

20 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be 21 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in 22 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 23 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society 24 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother

 Oklahoma;

9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal

in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates 15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency 16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical 17 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical 19 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in 20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical 21 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee 22 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician 23 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63 24 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
 2 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
 3 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
 4 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act

6 Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall 12. 7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates 8 9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims 10 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected 11 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for 12 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use 13 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to 14 provide services to crime victims;

15 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates 13. 16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate 17 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The 18 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 19 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of 20 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -21 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to 22 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

23 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
24 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the

Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.4 of this title;

7 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax 8 9 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and 10 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued 11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag 12 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an 13 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in 14 Section 1104.3 of this title;

15 Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates 16. 16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate 17 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The 18 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma 19 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As 20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be 21 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial 22 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of 23 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the State Department of Education in consultation with the 3 4 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to 5 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate 6 7 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three 8 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as 9 follows: 10 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education a. 11 Reform Revolving Fund, 12 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher b. 13 Education Revolving Fund, 14 five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State с. 15 Career Technology Fund, and 16 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be 17 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as 18 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the 19 Oklahoma Statutes. 20 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a 21 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial 22 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be 23 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this 24 paragraph;

24 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
