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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1711, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1711. <u>A.</u> The <u>Oklahoma Turnpike</u> Authority, subject to
16	the provisions hereof, is hereby authorized to fix, revise, charge
17	and collect tolls for the use of each turnpike project and the
18	different parts or sections thereof, except for use by $\frac{1}{1}$
19	following persons who shall be entitled to free use of every such
20	project:
21	1. Veterans as defined by Section 2 of Title 72 of the Oklahoma
22	Statutes; and
23	2. Law enforcement officers responsible for enforcing the
24	traffic laws and the general laws of the state and federal

1 governments on turnpikes, who shall be entitled to free use of every such project in the performance of official duties connected with 2 3 such turnpike project, and. The Authority, subject to the 4 provisions hereof, is also authorized to contract with any person, 5 partnership, association or corporation desiring the use of any part thereof, including the right-of-way adjoining the paved portion, for 6 7 placing thereon telephone, telegraph, electric light or power lines, gas stations, garages, stores, hotels, restaurants and advertising 8 9 signs, or for any other purpose except for tracks for railroad or 10 railway use, and to fix the terms, conditions, rents and rates of 11 charges for such use. Such tolls, subject to the other restrictions 12 hereof, shall be so fixed and adjusted in respect of the aggregate 13 of tolls from the turnpike project or projects in connection with 14 which the bonds of any issue shall have been issued as to provide a 15 fund sufficient with other revenues, if any, to pay (a) the cost of 16 maintaining, repairing, and operating such turnpike project or 17 projects, and (b) the principal of and the interest of such bonds as 18 the same shall become due and payable, and to create reserves for 19 such purposes. The tolls and all other revenues derived from the 20 turnpike project or projects in connection with which the bonds of 21 any issue shall have been issued, except such part thereof as may be 22 necessary to pay such cost of maintenance, repair, and operation and 23 to provide such reserves therefor as may be provided for in the 24 resolution authorizing the issuance of such bonds or in the trust

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1 agreement securing the same shall be set aside at such regular intervals as may be provided in such resolution or such trust 2 agreement in a sinking fund which is hereby pledged to, and charged 3 4 with, the payment of (a) the interest upon such bonds as such 5 interest shall fall due, (b) the principal of such bonds as the same shall fall due, (c) the necessary charges of paying agents for 6 7 paying principal and interest, and (d) the redemption price or the purchase price of bonds retired by call or purchase as therein 8 9 provided, which are a charge against such fund. The use and 10 disposition of monies to the credit of such sinking fund shall be 11 subject to the provisions of the resolution authorizing the issuance 12 of such bonds or of such trust agreement. Except as may otherwise be 13 provided in such resolution or such trust agreement, such sinking 14 fund shall be a fund for all such bonds without distinction or 15 priority of one over another. The monies in the sinking fund, less 16 such reserve as may be provided in such resolution or trust 17 agreement, if not used within a reasonable time for the purchase of 18 bonds for cancellation as above provided, shall be applied to the 19 redemption of bonds at the redemption price then applicable. Any 20 person who leases, rents, or acquires control of any gas station, 21 garage, store, hotel, or restaurant must have been a resident of, or 22 been doing business in, Oklahoma for the past five (5) years. 23 Notwithstanding anything else herein contained to the contrary, the 24 Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma shall exercise the

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1	jurisdiction now or hereafter vested in it to regulate and control
2	the operation of motor carriers of passengers and freight, using or
3	desiring to use any turnpike project, in the manner and to the
4	extent that it regulates or controls such carriers using the
5	highways of the state. The Authority shall not discriminate against
6	any group or class or individual member thereof in fixing the amount
7	of toll, rents, or charge for the use of the turnpike project.
8	B. The Authority shall promulgate any rules necessary to
9	implement the provisions of this section.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
