- 4. If more than two candidates qualify to have their names appear on the ballot, the names of all such candidates shall appear on the ballot at the board of education Primary Election. A candidate receiving more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast in the board of education Primary Election shall be elected to the office. If no candidate receives more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast in the election provided for in this subsection, an election between board of education Primary Election, then the two candidates with the highest number of votes shall be conducted on the first Tuesday in April of that year appear on the ballot at the board of education General Election.
- B. Elections on the question of making a levy or levies for schools under Section 9, Section 9B or Section 10 of Article X of

- C. The board of education of every school district or technology center school district may call a special election for the purpose of voting on any matter or question authorized by law.
