NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5051.6 of Title 63, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 To the extent allowed under federal law, any provider enrolled 18 in the Oklahoma Medicaid program may bill the Oklahoma Health Care 19 Authority for Home- and Community-Based Services performed up to one 20 (1) year after the date the service was performed. Travel expenses 21 shall not be subject to reimbursement. If a claim is initially 22 denied, the provider may submit a subsequent claim up to one (1) 23 year after the date the original claim was denied; provided, the 24 provider may only utilize this provision once per claim.
