8	An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
9	2011, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5, as last amended by Sections 23 and 25, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S.
10	Supp. 2016, Sections 1135.3 and 1135.5), which relate to special license plates; reclassifying the Ducks
11	Unlimited license plate to a financial support license plate; authorizing certain licensing
12	agreements; providing for certain payments; limiting certain payments; correcting references; and
13	providing an effective date.
14	
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
17	last amended by Section 23, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp.
18	2016, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
20	authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
21	plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
22	membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
23	subject as provided by this section.
24	

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 15 applications for special license plates authorized under this 16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 23 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 24 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 6 7 After such time the expired special license plate shall be date. removed from the vehicle. 8

9 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special 10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special 11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission 12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications 13 The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax therefor. 14 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective 15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null 16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are 17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time 18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for

issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall 7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an 8 9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a 10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an 11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an 12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate 13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate 14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star 15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of 18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of 19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus 21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights 22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the 23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation

9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and

Unless otherwise provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows: 8 9 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be 10 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be 11 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and 12 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the 13 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in 14 Section 1104 of this title.

Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide financial assistance as provided by this section.

22 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other 23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of 24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax 4 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall 5 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. 6 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 7 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor 8 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be 9 issued on a staggered system.

10 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept 12 applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's 14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 24 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 1 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special 2 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 3 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration 4 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 5 removed from the vehicle.

6 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, 7 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax 8 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid 9 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by 10 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the 11 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall 12 be null and void.
