6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending 69  
8 O.S. 2011, Section 902, which relates to maintenance  
9 authority of county road and state highway  
10 intersections; modifying certain maintenance  
11 responsibility; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 902, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 902. A. At the intersection of a county road and a  
16 state highway, within the state's right of way the ~~county~~ Department  
17 of Transportation shall maintain the county road to the point where  
18 it intersects with the travel lanes of the highway or the improved  
19 shoulder. The Department of Transportation shall maintain the  
20 existing signage at the intersections to include replacement or  
21 relocation of stop signs and vegetation control within three (3)  
22 feet of the stop sign whether or not the sign is within the county  
23 right-of-way. The Department shall also maintain drainage  
24 structures that are within the state's right-of-way, that lie under

1 county roads at the intersections of county roads and state  
2 highways. The Department may place and maintain new or additional  
3 signs at any such intersection at the discretion of the Department.  
4 The county shall maintain any advance warning sign and sight line  
5 vegetation control to the intersection. The county may obtain from  
6 the Department, at no cost to the county, replacement advance  
7 warning signs.

8 B. The Department of Transportation shall maintain the  
9 structure of bridges and overpasses where a county road crosses over  
10 or under a state highway. The repair and maintenance of the county  
11 road shall be the responsibility of the county.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.

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
