| 13 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:  |
| 14 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 323, O.S.L.   |
| 15 | 2018 (70 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 24-100.8), is amended to read as   |
| 16 | follows:   |
| 17 | Section 24-100.8 A. As used in this section, "threatening  |
| 18 | behavior" means any verbal threat or threatening behavior, whether   |
| 19 | or not it is directed at another person, which indicates potential   |
| 20 | for future harm to students, school personnel or school property.  |
| 21 | B. An officer or employee of a school district or member of a  |
| 22 | board of education shall notify law enforcement of any verbal threat   |
| 23 | or act of threatening behavior which reasonably may have the   |
| 24 | potential to endanger students, school personnel or school property.   |

C. Officers or employees of a school district or members of a
 board of education shall be immune from employment discipline and
 any civil liability for communicating information pursuant to
 subsection B of this section in good faith if they reasonably
 believe a person is making verbal threats or is exhibiting
 threatening behavior.

D. <u>The school district shall develop a policy to determine if a</u>
<u>student who engages in threatening behavior that has the potential</u>
<u>to cause severe bodily harm or extreme violence needs to complete a</u>
<u>mental health assessment and evaluation administered by assessment</u>
<u>personnel certified by the Department of Mental Health and Substance</u>
<u>Abuse Services prior to returning to school.</u>

<u>E.</u> Nothing in this section shall be construed to impose a
 specific liability on any school district.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
