AS INTRODUCED
An Act relating to teachers; requiring emergency- certified teachers to complete professional
development training prior to teaching; directing school district to provide training; permitting
cooperation with other districts or higher education institutions; prescribing topics for training;
mandating additional training throughout the year; requiring mentor for support, guidance and advice;
providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-195.3 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. A person who is issued an emergency certificate by the State
Board of Education pursuant to subsection F of Section 6-187 of
Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes and who does not already hold a
standard certificate shall complete professional development
training prior to entering the classroom.
B. The training shall be offered by the employing school
district. School districts may cooperate with other districts or

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1 contract with an institution of higher education to offer the
2 training.

3 C. The training described in this section shall include, at a 4 minimum, the following topics:

- 5 1. Classroom management skills;
- 6 2. Subject-specific instructional methods;
- 7 3. School procedures and policies; and
- 8 4. Writing lesson plans.

9 D. The school district shall provide additional training
10 opportunities throughout the school year. In addition to an
11 instructional coach, the school principal shall also arrange a
12 mentor to provide support, guidance and advice to the emergency13 certified teacher on an ongoing basis.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
