11	unlawful; and providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-404, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 7-404. A. The State Board of Agriculture shall
18	promulgate rules governing:
19	1. The production, transportation, processing, pasteurization,
20	handling, identity, sampling, examination, labeling, marking,
21	shipping statements, optional ingredients, definitions, and sanitary
22	conditions for milk and milk products;
23	2. The inspection and sanitary rating of dairy farms, bulk milk
24	hauler/samplers, milk transportation companies, milk tank truck

1 cleaning facilities, milk plants, and distribution centers engaged 2 in producing, transporting, processing, and distributing milk and 3 milk products;

3. The issuing, modifying, suspending, and revoking of permits
to producers, bulk milk hauler/samplers, milk transportation
companies, milk tank truck cleaning facilities, processors, and
distributors of milk and milk products;

8 4. The approval of facilities therefor except for waste
9 disposal therefrom, which shall be regulated by the Department of
10 Environmental Quality;

11 5. All cheese factories;

12 6. All modes of transportation used for the distribution of13 milk and cream to market; and

14 7. The labeling and packaging of milk and milk products.

B. The rules promulgated by the Board shall be in accord with
the minimum standards and requirements for milk and milk products
currently recommended and established by the United States
Department of Health and Human Services, Food and Drug
Administration, including the Recommended Grade A Pasteurized Milk
Ordinance.

21SECTION 2.AMENDATORY2 O.S. 2011, Section 7-413, is22amended to read as follows:

23 Section 7-413. It shall be unlawful for any person to

24 knowingly, willfully, recklessly, or negligently:

1 1. Attempt to produce, haul, process, or distribute milk or 2 milk products without an appropriate and valid permit; 3 2. Sell, offer, or expose for sale as Grade A any adulterated 4 or misbranded milk or milk product; 5 3. Sell, offer, expose for sale, or serve milk and milk products which have not been maintained at or below the temperature 6 7 specified by the State Board of Agriculture; Dip or ladle Grade A milk and milk products; 8 4. 9 5. Transfer Grade A milk and milk products at any location 10 other than a permitted Grade A facility designed and equipped for 11 such purpose; 12 6. Prevent, interfere, or attempt to impede the Commissioner 13 from investigating and enforcing the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products 14 Act; 15 7. Sell or serve Grade A milk and milk products from other than 16 the individual container, or approved bulk dispenser, received from 17 the distributor; or 18 8. Violate any provision of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products 19 Act. 20 SECTION 3.
