12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1248 of Title 21, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. It shall be unlawful for the operator or passenger of a
16	motor vehicle to smoke cigarettes, pipes or cigars if a child is
17	also present in the motor vehicle.
18	B. Any person who is convicted of violating the provisions of
19	this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred
20	Dollars (\$100.00).
21	C. No law enforcement officer shall make routine stops of
22	motorists for the purpose of enforcing this section.

1. "Child" shall mean any person who is fourteen (14) years of
2 age or younger; and

2. "Motor vehicle" shall mean any type of conveyance or device in, upon or by which a person or property is or may be transported from one location to another upon the avenues of public access within this state. Motor vehicle shall include the passenger compartment of pickups, vans, minivans and sport utility vehicles. Motor vehicle shall not include trucks, truck-tractors, recreational vehicles, motorcycles or motorized bicycles. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017. 56-1-5420 JM 12/13/16
