14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 394, O.S.L.
15	2013, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 322, O.S.L. 2016 (70 O.S.
16	Supp. 2016, Section 18-114.14), is amended to read as follows:
17	Section 18-114.14 A. Beginning with the 2013-2014 <u>2017-2018</u>
18	school year, teachers in the public schools of Oklahoma shall
19	receive in salary and/or fringe benefits not less than the amounts
20	specified in the following schedule:

When determining the Minimum Salary Schedule, "fringe 12 Β. 13 benefits" shall mean all or part of retirement benefits, excluding 14 the contributions made pursuant to subsection A of Section 17-108.1 15 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title and the flexible 16 benefit allowance pursuant to Section 26-105 of Title 70 of the 17 Oklahoma Statutes this title from the flexible benefit allowance 18 funds disbursed by the State Board of Education and the State Board 19 of Career and Technology Education pursuant to Section 26-104 of 20 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title.

C. Any of the degrees referred to in this section shall be from a college recognized by the State Board of Education. The Board shall accept teaching experience from out-of-state school districts that are accredited by the state board of education or appropriate

state accrediting agency for the districts. The Board shall accept 1 2 teaching experience from out-of-country schools that are accredited 3 or otherwise endorsed by the appropriate national or regional 4 accrediting or endorsement authority. Out-of-country certification 5 documentation in a language other than English shall be analyzed by an educational credential evaluation service approved by the 6 7 National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES). The person seeking to have credit granted for out-of-country teaching 8 9 experience shall be responsible for all costs of the analysis by a 10 credential evaluation service. The Board shall accept teaching 11 experience from primary and secondary schools that are operated by 12 the United States Department of Defense or are affiliated with the 13 United States Department of State.

D. For the purpose of state salary increments and retirement, no teacher shall be granted credit for more than five (5) years of active duty in the military service or out-of-state or out-ofcountry teaching experience as a certified teacher or its equivalent. Nothing in this section shall prohibit boards of education from crediting more years of experience on district salary schedules than those allowed for state purposes.

E. The State Board of Education shall recognize, for purposes of certification and salary increments, all the years of experience of a:

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Certified teacher who teaches in the educational program of
 the Department of Corrections, beginning with fiscal year 1981;

2. Vocational rehabilitation counselor under the Department of
Human Services if the counselor was employed as a certified teacher
by the State Department of Education when the Division of Vocational
Rehabilitation was transferred from the State Board of Career and
Technology Education or the State Board of Education to the Oklahoma
Public Welfare Commission on July 1, 1968;

9 3. Vocational rehabilitation counselor which were completed 10 while employed by the Department of Human Services if such counselor 11 was certified as a teacher or was eligible for certification as a 12 teacher in Oklahoma;

4. Certified teacher which were completed while employed by the
 Department of Human Services Child Study Center at University
 Hospital, if the teacher was certified as a teacher in Oklahoma; and

Certified school psychologist or psychometrist which were 17 completed while employed as a doctoral intern, psychological 18 assistant, or psychologist with any agency of the State of Oklahoma 19 if the experience primarily involved work with persons of school- or 20 preschool-age and if the person was, at the time the experience was 21 acquired, certified as, or eligible for certification as, a school 22 psychologist or psychometrist.

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1	F. The provisions of this section shall not apply to teachers
2	who have entered into postretirement employment with a public school
3	in Oklahoma and are still receiving a monthly retirement benefit.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
5	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
