13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-2.16, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 840-2.16 Except as otherwise provided by law, any  
17 classified, unclassified or exempt employee of the state, excluding  
18 members of boards and commissions, institutions under the  
19 administrative authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
20 Education, employees of public school districts and elected  
21 officials, on July 1 of each year, earning less than the amount  
22 established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a ~~three-person~~  
23 four-person household, issued each year in the Federal Register by  
24 the United States Department of Health and Human Services, shall

1 receive the necessary grade or salary adjustment to provide for a  
2 minimum annualized salary equal to the amount established in the  
3 Federal Poverty Guidelines for a ~~three-person~~ four-person household,  
4 issued each year in the Federal Register by the United States  
5 Department of Health and Human Services. Any classified,  
6 unclassified or exempt employee of the state, excluding members of  
7 boards and commissions, institutions under the administrative  
8 authority of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education,  
9 employees of public school districts and elected officials, employed  
10 after July 1, 2007, shall receive a minimum annualized salary equal  
11 to the amount established in the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a  
12 ~~three-person~~ four-person household, issued each year in the Federal  
13 Register by the United States Department of Health and Human  
14 Services. This section shall not apply to those persons employed  
15 pursuant to paragraph 8 and paragraph 12 of subsection A of Section  
16 840-5.5 and Section 2241 of this title or those persons employed  
17 pursuant to Section 1.6a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
