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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 2104, as
13 amended by Section 237, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (68 O.S. Supp.
14 2022, Section 2104), is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 2104. A. The value of any motor vehicle, except a
16 manufactured home, for the purposes of the excise tax levied by
17 Section 2103 of this title, shall be determined as of the time the
18 person applying for a certificate of title thereto obtained either
19 ownership or possession of the vehicle, which shall be presumed to
20 be the actual date of the sale or other transfer of ownership, and
21 assignment of the certificate of title.

22 B. 1. The value of any vehicle, for purposes of the excise tax
23 levied by Section 2103 of this title, shall be the actual sales
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1 price of such a vehicle ~~before~~ after any discounts or credits are
2 given for a trade-in. ~~However, the value~~

3 2. For purposes of computing the maximum value or the minimum
4 value of the vehicle to calculate the amount of motor vehicle excise
5 tax due, and notwithstanding the actual sales price of the vehicle
6 as negotiated between the seller and buyer, the sales price of the
7 vehicle prior to the subtraction of such discounts or credits for a
8 trade-in shall be required to be within twenty percent (20%) of the
9 average retail price ~~value~~ of such vehicle as listed in the
10 automotive reference material prescribed by Service Oklahoma.

11 3. The ~~actual sales price value~~ of the vehicle as computed in
12 paragraph 1 of this subsection, which total shall be the basis of
13 the motor vehicle excise tax, as well as:

14 a. the sales price of the vehicle for purposes of
15 paragraph 2 of this subsection,

16 b. the number of tires on the vehicle, and

17 c. the tire rim diameters,

18 shall be entered on the bill of sale furnished by the seller to the
19 purchaser, or on such other form as may be prescribed by Service
20 Oklahoma.

21 C. Upon receipt of the properly completed bill of sale or other
22 form as prescribed by Service Oklahoma, and the payment of all
23 applicable taxes and fees, Service Oklahoma or an appointed licensed
24 operator shall issue a vehicle certificate of title in accordance

1 with the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration
2 Act.

3 D. On or before November 1, 2025, Service Oklahoma shall file a
4 report with the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
5 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
6 Senate, the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the
7 House of Representatives, and the Chair of the Appropriations
8 Committee of the Senate. The report shall state the fiscal impact
9 of the motor vehicle excise tax over the previous three (3) fiscal
10 years, the future projections of the motor vehicle excise tax, and
11 any other information important to the implementation and fiscal
12 impact of the motor vehicle excise tax.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
