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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5060.44 of Title 74, unless
20	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. There is hereby created the Science and Technology Policy
22	Advisor, who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and
23	consent of the Senate and serve at the pleasure of the Governor.
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1	B. The Science and Technology Policy Advisor shall have
2	completed at a minimum a master's level degree from an accredited
3	university or college in a science, technology, engineering or
4	mathematics (STEM) field.
5	C. The Science and Technology Policy Advisor shall select an
6	advisory board made up of no more than twelve (12) members, and the
7	board shall be known as the Science and Technology Policy Advisory
8	Board. Board members shall serve two-year terms and no more than
9	four consecutive terms.
10	SECTION 2. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Section 5060.40, is
11	hereby repealed.
12	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
