7 An Act relating to developmental disability programs;
8 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 129.7, as renumbered
9 by Section 43, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2013, and as last
10 amended by Section 9, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2014 (61
11 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 331), which relates to
12 leases of certain surplus lands; modifying authorized
13 use of lease revenues; directing Department of Human
14 Services to promulgate rules; requiring submission of
15 itemized report of account income and expenditures;
16 amending 62 O.S. 2011, Section 166d, as amended by
17 Section 455, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (62 O.S. Supp.
18 2014, Section 166d), which relates to certain bonuses
19 and royalties; modifying authorized disposition of
20 royalties; providing for use of revenues during
21 operation of Southern Oklahoma Resource Center;
22 providing for use of revenues during specified time
23 period; providing for use of revenues in programs to
24 assist intellectually disabled persons; directing
Department to promulgate rules; requiring submission
of itemized report of account income and
expenditures; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 129.7, as
renumbered by Section 43, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2013, and as last
amended by Section 9, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2014 (61 O.S. Supp. 2014,
Section 331), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 331. In addition to the land described in Section 329
2 of this title, the Department of Human Services, with approval of
3 the Director, may lease other surplus land and property at the
4 Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley to an individual
5 or individuals or to an entity. Revenue from such lease shall be
6 placed in a special agency clearing account to be used for the
7 benefit of the residents of the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of
8 Pauls Valley as long as the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of
9 Pauls Valley remains in operation and for three (3) months
10 thereafter. Upon expiration of the three (3) months after closure,
11 the revenue shall be placed in a special agency clearing account to
12 be used for establishing and maintaining community households for
13 people with intellectual disabilities served by Developmental
14 Disabilities Services at the Department of Human Services. The
15 Department of Human Services shall promulgate rules for the
16 administration of the fund and specific items allowed. The
17 Department of Human Services shall submit an itemized report of all
18 income and expenditures to the account to the Governor, President
19 Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives annually.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 166d, as
22 amended by Section 455, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (62 O.S. Supp.
23 2014, Section 166d), is amended to read as follows:
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1 Section 166d. All royalty monies received upon behalf of this
2 state, any and all bonus monies received upon behalf of this state,
3 and any and all delay rentals received upon behalf of this state, in
4 connection with or pursuant to the provisions of any oil and gas
5 lease covering any of the lands occupied by, or assigned to the use
6 of, the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley, entered
7 into by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, shall be
8 deposited in the revolving fund of the Southern Oklahoma Resource
9 Center of Pauls Valley and shall be expended by said institution in
10 the same manner that other treasury funds of said institution are
11 expended as long as the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls
12 Valley remains in operation and for three (3) months thereafter.
13 Upon expiration of the three (3) months after closure, the revenue
14 shall be placed in a special agency clearing account to be used for
15 establishing and maintaining community households for people with
16 intellectual disabilities served by Developmental Disabilities
17 Services at the Department of Human Services. The Department of
18 Human Services shall promulgate rules for the administration of the
19 fund and specific items allowed. The Department of Human Services
20 shall submit an itemized report of all income and expenditures to
21 the account to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
22 Speaker of the House of Representatives annually.

23 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
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
