NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 456.4 of Title 74, unless there 14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 15 In the event that any federal court or court of this state makes 16 a final determination that a law enacted by bill or joint resolution 17 by the Oklahoma Legislature violates either the Constitution of the 18 United States of America or the Constitution of the State of 19 Oklahoma, the amount of any litigation costs incurred by the state, 20 or any of its political subdivisions, in challenges to the 21 constitutionality of the legislation and paid by this state or any 22 of its political subdivisions to the prevailing party in such action 23 shall be reimbursed to the Office of the Attorney General or to the 24 appropriate political subdivision in an amount not to exceed Forty-

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six Dollars ($46.00) to be paid by the authors of the legislation
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    and deducted from their legislative salaries.
