AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; requiring certain applicants sign an affidavit of noncollusion; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 846 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person applying for employment with the state or any political subdivision of the state shall sign an affidavit of noncollusion stating that the individual is not in collusion with any elected official in Oklahoma to gain employment with the state or a political subdivision of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
