6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; requiring school district  
8 to pay certain increased compensation to teachers  
9 under certain circumstances; requiring board of  
10 education to make certain determination; providing  
11 for codification; providing an effective date; and  
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-113.6 of Title 70, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, if a school  
18 district incurs penalties for exceeding class size limitations  
19 established in Sections 18-113.1, 18-113.2 and 18-113.3 of Title 70  
20 of the Oklahoma Statutes, such district shall be required to pay an  
21 increase in compensation to any teacher whose classroom has exceeded  
22 the class size limitations.

23 B. Each board of education shall determine the amount of  
24 required increase in compensation set forth in subsection A,

1 provided that a teacher shall receive a minimum of One Thousand  
2 Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each student that exceeds the class size  
3 limitations set forth in subsection A and with total increased  
4 compensation not to exceed a maximum of Five Thousand dollars  
5 (\$5,000.00).

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
