16	Any person or lawfully recognized business entity shall have the
17	right to decline the installation of a "smart meter" or any similar
18	device that monitors electrical usage in real time or which
19	broadcasts information regarding electrical usage using radio waves
20	or other forms of electromagnetic radiation.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
