AMENDATORY 3A O.S. 2011, Section 604.1, as 16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 231, O.S.L. 2015 (3A O.S. Supp. 17 2018, Section 604.1), is amended to read as follows: 18 Section 604.1 A. There is hereby re-created, until July 1, 19 2019 2020, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law, the Oklahoma 20 State Athletic Commission, which shall be composed of nine (9) 21 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the 22 Senate. The member of the Commission initially appointed pursuant 23 to this act shall serve a term of three (3) years that shall expire 24 on June 30, 2006. Members appointed to the Commission shall serve

- 1 | for terms of three (3) years. Terms of office shall expire on June
- 2 | 30. All vacancies and unexpired terms shall be filled in the same
- 3 | manner as the original appointment and within sixty (60) days from
- 4 the date of the vacancy. Members may be removed by the Governor for
- 5 | incompetence, willful neglect of duty, corruption in office, or
- 6 malfeasance in office.
- 7 B. Members appointed to the Commission shall reside in this
- 8 state and shall have the following qualifications:
- 9 1. Two members shall have experience as a professional

- 12 2. One member shall have experience as a professional wrestler
- 13 or in professional wrestling promotions;
 - 3. One member shall have experience in sports medicine;
- 4. One member shall have experience in the cable television

- 5. Four members shall represent the public at large as lay

- 19 C. No member of the Commission or any person related to a
- 20 member within the third degree by consanguinity or affinity shall
- 21 promote, sponsor, or have any financial interest in the promotion or
- 22 | sponsorship of any professional combative sports event or amateur
- 23 | mixed martial arts event while a member of the Commission.

1	D. The members of the Commission shall elect from their
2	membership a chair and vice-chair to serve for one-year terms. A
3	majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of
4	conducting the business of the Commission. The Commission shall
5	meet at least quarterly, and special meetings may be called by the
6	chair.
7	E. The Commission shall comply with the provisions of the
8	Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, the Oklahoma Open Records Act, and the
9	Administrative Procedures Act.
10	F. All members of the Commission and such employees as
11	determined by the Commission shall be bonded as required by Sections
12	85.26 through 85.31 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
13	G. Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation
14	but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of
15	their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
