18	Section 604.1 A. There is hereby re-created, until July 1,
19	2019 2020, in accordance with the Oklahoma Sunset Law, the Oklahoma
20	State Athletic Commission, which shall be composed of nine (9)
21	members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
22	Senate. The member of the Commission initially appointed pursuant
23	to this act shall serve a term of three (3) years that shall expire
24	on June 30, 2006. Members appointed to the Commission shall serve

SENATE FLOOR VERSION - HB1435 SFLR (Bold face denotes Committee Amendments) for terms of three (3) years. Terms of office shall expire on June 30. All vacancies and unexpired terms shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment and within sixty (60) days from the date of the vacancy. Members may be removed by the Governor for incompetence, willful neglect of duty, corruption in office, or malfeasance in office.

B. Members appointed to the Commission shall reside in this8 state and shall have the following qualifications:

9 1. Two members shall have experience as a professional
10 combative sports practitioner, other than as a professional wrestler
11 or in professional combative sports promotions;

One member shall have experience as a professional wrestler
 or in professional wrestling promotions;

One member shall have experience in sports medicine;
 One member shall have experience in the cable television
 business; and

17 5. Four members shall represent the public at large as lay18 members.

19 C. No member of the Commission or any person related to a 20 member within the third degree by consanguinity or affinity shall 21 promote, sponsor, or have any financial interest in the promotion or 22 sponsorship of any professional combative sports event or amateur 23 mixed martial arts event while a member of the Commission.

SENATE FLOOR VERSION - HB1435 SFLR (Bold face denotes Committee Amendments) D. The members of the Commission shall elect from their membership a chair and vice-chair to serve for one-year terms. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting the business of the Commission. The Commission shall meet at least quarterly, and special meetings may be called by the chair.

7 E. The Commission shall comply with the provisions of the
8 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, the Oklahoma Open Records Act, and the
9 Administrative Procedures Act.

F. All members of the Commission and such employees as
determined by the Commission shall be bonded as required by Sections
85.26 through 85.31 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

G. Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation
but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of
their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
