19	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9101 of Title 74, unless there
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	As used in the Rural Small Business Assistance Act of 2017:
23	1. "Business" means any lawful for-profit enterprise;

2. "Employee" means an individual whose regular job duties require the performance of at least two thousand (2,000) hours of work each calendar year or fiscal year;

- 3. "Rural area" means any county of the state having a population of less than one hundred thousand (100,000) persons according to the latest Federal Decennial Census or most recent population estimate;
- 3. "Small business" means a business having less than one hundred (100) full-time employees which either has its principal place of business located in a rural area or conducts fifty percent (50%) or more of its business with persons or business entities which, respectively, reside or are primarily located in a rural area.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9102 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be designated the "Rural Small Business Assistance Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce from such sources as provided by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the
