10	An Act relating to property; amending 60 O.S. 2011, Sections 121 and 122, which relate to alien ownership
11	of land; prohibiting certain ownership of land through business entity or trust; requiring certain
12 13	companies to inform Attorney General or district attorney of potential sale; requiring pause of certain transactions pending investigation; allowing
14	resumption of certain transactions upon approval; requiring termination of certain transactions;
15	<pre>modifying exception to certain ownership requirements; making language gender-neutral;</pre>
16	updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.
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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 60 O.S. 2011, Section 121, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Section 121. No alien or any person who is not a citizen of the
23	United States shall acquire title to or own land in the State of
24	Oklahoma this state either directly or indirectly through a business

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1 entity or trust, except as hereinafter provided, but he or she shall 2 have and enjoy in the State of Oklahoma this state such rights as to 3 personal property as are, or shall be accorded a citizen of the United States under the laws of the nation to which such alien 4 5 belongs, or by the treaties of such nation with the United States, 6 except as the same may be affected by the provisions of this act 7 Section 121 et seq. of this title or the Constitution of this state. Any abstract company, closing company or title company with reason 8 9 to believe that a client is attempting to purchase land in this 10 state in violation of the provisions of this article shall inform 11 the Attorney General or the district attorney of the county where 12 the land is located and shall pause the transaction for the duration of the investigation of the Attorney General or district attorney. 13 Upon completion of an investigation, a transaction for sale of the 14 15 property may be resumed upon approval of the Attorney General or 16 district attorney. If the Attorney General or district attorney determines that the sale of the property would violate the 17 provisions of this article, the transaction shall be terminated. 18 SECTION 2. 60 O.S. 2011, Section 122, is 19 AMENDATORY amended to read as follows: 20 Section 122. This article shall not apply to lands now owned in 21 this state by aliens so long as they are held by the present owners, 22 nor to any alien who is or shall take up bona fide residence in this 23 state: and; provided, that any alien who is or shall become a bona 24

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1	fide resident of the State of Oklahoma, or any lawfully recognized
2	business entity, the majority of the voting stock or equivalent
3	controlling equity interest of which is owned by one or more
4	resident aliens, shall have the right to acquire and hold lands in
5	this state upon the same terms as citizens of the State of Oklahoma
6	during the continuance of such bona fide residence of such alien in
7	this state: Provided, that if any such resident alien shall cease
8	to be a bona fide inhabitant of this state, such alien shall have
9	five (5) years from the time he <u>or she</u> ceased to be such bona fide
10	resident in which to alienate such lands.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
