An Act relating to schools; defining the phrase per-pupil expenditure; listing expenditure categories; excluding certain expenditures; providing for application; requiring the reporting or publishing of certain categories; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, substitute the following for the title, enacting clause and the entire body of the bill:

"[schools - per-pupil expenditure - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, the phrase "per-pupil expenditure" shall mean the aggregate current expenditures of school districts, from all funding sources including federal funds, plus the aggregate current expenditures of the state for the State

1 Department of Education, which shall include expenditures for the
2 State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Public
3 Instruction, plus the direct support aggregate current expenditures
4 of the state for the day-to-day operations of schools and school
5 districts from all funding sources including federal funds, divided
6 by the aggregate number of students in average daily membership to
7 whom school districts in the state provide a public education for
8 the same fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined. The
9 aggregate current expenditures shall include without limitation the
10 following categories of expenditures:

- 11 1. Instruction;
- 12 2. Support services students;
- 13 3. Support services instructional staff;
- 14 4. Support services general administration;
- 15 5. Support services school administration;
- 16 6. Support services business;
- 17 7. Operation and maintenance of plant services;
- 18 8. Student transportation services;
- 19 9. Child nutrition services; and
- 20 10. Enterprise services.

21 B. Aggregate current expenditures shall not include
22 expenditures for adult and community education, facilities
23 acquisition and construction services, debt services, property, and
24 other expenditures not related to the day-to-day operations.

1 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
2 when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational and
3 governmental entities. When reporting or publishing the per-pupil
4 expenditure for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall
5 also report or publish each category of expenditure as listed in
6 subsection A of this section as well as the aggregate expenditure.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015."

23 the direct support aggregate current expenditures of the state for
24 the day-to-day operations of schools and school districts from all
funding sources including federal funds divided by the aggregate

1 number of students in average daily membership to whom school
2 districts in the state provide a public education for the same
3 fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined. The
4 aggregate current expenditures shall include without limitation the
5 following categories of expenditures:

- 6 1. Instruction and instruction-related;
- 7 2. Instructional staff support services;
- 8 3. General and school administration;
- 9 4. Operations and maintenance;
- 10 5. Student support services;
- 11 6. Employee benefits;
- 12 7. Employee retirement benefits; and
- 13 8. Transportation and food services.

14 B. Aggregate current expenditures shall not include
15 expenditures for capital outlay and capital debt service which
16 includes, but is not limited to, the purchase of lands, bond issue
17 debt service, school construction and school repair.

18 C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply
19 when related to the expenditure of public funds by educational and
20 governmental entities. When reporting or publishing the per-pupil
21 expenditure for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall
22 also report or publish each category of expenditure as listed in
23 subsection A of this section as well as the aggregate expenditure.

24 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
