BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-124 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Unless otherwise specifically defined, the phrase "per-pupil expenditure" shall mean the aggregate current expenditures of school districts from all funding sources including federal funds plus the aggregate current expenditures of the state for the State Department of Education which shall include expenditures for the State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction plus the direct support aggregate current expenditures of the state for the day-to-day operations of schools and school districts from all funding sources including federal funds divided by the aggregate

- 1 | number of students in average daily membership to whom school
- 2 districts in the state provide a public education for the same
- 3 | fiscal year for which the expenditures are determined. The
- 4 | aggregate current expenditures shall include without limitation the
