Plate Revolving Fund; placing fund with the Oklahoma  
Department of Veterans Affairs; providing for budget  
and expenditure procedures related to such fund;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1113, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 1113. A. 1. Except for all-terrain vehicles, utility  
vehicles and motorcycles used exclusively off roads and highways,

1 upon the filing of a registration application and the payment of the  
2 fees provided for in the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration  
3 Act, the Oklahoma Tax Commission or Corporation Commission, as  
4 applicable, shall assign to the vehicle described in the application  
5 a distinctive number, and issue to the owner of the vehicle a  
6 certificate of registration, one license plate and a yearly decal.  
7 The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall assign an all-terrain vehicle,  
8 utility vehicle or motorcycle used exclusively off roads and  
9 highways a distinctive number and issue to the owner a certificate  
10 of registration and a decal but not a license plate. For each  
11 subsequent registration year, the Tax Commission shall issue a  
12 yearly decal to be affixed to the license plate, except for an all-  
13 terrain vehicle, utility vehicle or motorcycle used exclusively off  
14 roads and highways. The initial decal for an all-terrain vehicle,  
15 utility vehicle or motorcycle shall be attached to the front of the  
16 vehicle and shall be in clear view. The decal shall be on the front  
17 or on the front fork of the motorcycle used exclusively off roads  
18 and highways and the decal shall be in clear view. The yearly decal  
19 shall have an identification number and the last two numbers of the  
20 registration year for which it shall expire. Except as provided by  
21 Section 1113A of this title, the license plate shall be affixed to  
22 the exterior of the vehicle until a replacement license plate is  
23 applied for. If the owner applies for a replacement license plate,  
24 the Tax Commission shall charge the fee provided for in Section 1114

1 of this title. The yearly decal will validate the license plate for  
2 each registration period other than the year the license plate is  
3 issued. The license plate and decal shall be of such size, color,  
4 design and numbering as the Tax Commission may direct. However,  
5 yearly decals issued to the owner of a vehicle who has filed an  
6 affidavit with the appropriate motor license agent in accordance  
7 with Section 7-607 of this title shall be a separate and distinct  
8 color from all other decals issued under this section. The Tax  
9 Commission shall also issue a monthly decal which shall include a  
10 two-letter abbreviation corresponding to the county in which the  
11 vehicle is registered. The Tax Commission is hereby directed to  
12 develop the decal design to incorporate these requirements in a  
13 manner that will permit county abbreviation to be readily  
14 identified. The Tax Commission shall develop a unique two-letter  
15 abbreviation for each county to be used on the decals. The Tax  
16 Commission shall issue all decals in the possession of the Tax  
17 Commission on January 1, 2010, prior to issuing any of the county  
18 abbreviation decals created pursuant to this paragraph.

19 2. The license plate shall be securely attached to the rear of  
20 the vehicle, except truck-tractor plates which shall be attached to  
21 the front of the vehicle. The Tax Commission may, with the  
22 concurrence of the Department of Public Safety, by Joint Rule,  
23 change and direct the manner, place and location of display of any  
24 vehicle license plate when such action is deemed in the public

1 interest. The license plate, decal and all letters and numbers  
2 shall be clearly visible at all times. The operation of a vehicle  
3 in this state, regardless of where such vehicle is registered, upon  
4 which the license plate is covered, overlaid or otherwise screened  
5 with any material, whether such material be clear, translucent,  
6 tinted or opaque, shall be a violation of this paragraph.

7 3. Upon payment of the annual registration fee provided in  
8 Section 1133 of this title, the Tax Commission or Corporation  
9 Commission, as applicable, or a motor license agent may issue a  
10 permanent nonexpiring license plate to an owner of one hundred or  
11 more commercial motor vehicles and for vehicles registered under the  
12 provisions of Section 1120 of this title. Upon payment of the  
13 annual registration fee, the Tax Commission or Corporation  
14 Commission shall issue a certificate of registration that shall be  
15 carried at all times in the vehicle for which it is issued.  
16 Provided, if the registrant submits its application through  
17 electronic means, such qualified owners of one hundred or more  
18 commercial motor vehicles, properly registered pursuant to the  
19 provisions of Section 1133 of this title, may elect to receive a  
20 permanent certificate of registration that shall be carried at all  
21 times in the vehicle for which it is issued.

22 4. Every vehicle owned by an agency of this state shall be  
23 exempt from the payment of registration fees required by this title.  
24 Provided, such vehicle shall be registered and shall otherwise

1 comply with the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
2 Registration Act.

3 B. The license plates required under the provisions of this  
4 title shall conform to the requirements and specifications listed  
5 hereinafter:

6 1. Each license plate shall have a space for the placement of  
7 the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the  
8 initial issue;

9 2. The provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and  
10 Registration Act regarding the issuance of yearly decals shall not  
11 apply to the issuance of apportioned license plates, including  
12 license plates for state vehicles, and exempt plates for  
13 governmental entities and fire departments organized pursuant to  
14 Section 592 of Title 18 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 3. Within the limits herein prescribed the Tax Commission shall  
16 redesign the official vehicle license plates which currently bear  
17 the legend "Oklahoma OK" or "Oklahoma is OK!" and substitute  
18 therefor the legend "Oklahoma Native America" as further described  
19 in this paragraph. Except for personalized license plates and  
20 license plates issued for motorcycles and mopeds, the emblem on the  
21 state flag of Oklahoma as provided for in Section 91 of Title 25 of  
22 the Oklahoma Statutes shall be a part of all license plates issued  
23 after December 31, 1988. The Tax Commission may continue to issue  
24 license plates with the legend "Oklahoma is OK!" or "Oklahoma OK"

1 until any inventory of such license plates is depleted but the Tax  
2 Commission shall not produce or cause to be produced any additional  
3 license plates with these legends. Except for personalized license  
4 plates, license plates issued for commercial vehicles, and license  
5 plates issued for motorcycles and mopeds, the "Oklahoma Native  
6 America" emblem shall be a part of all license plates issued after  
7 December 31, 1993. The specifications for lettering style and  
8 appearance for the legend "Oklahoma Native America" shall be  
9 provided to the Tax Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and  
10 Recreation Department. All license plates and decals shall be made  
11 with reflectorized material as a background to the letters, numbers  
12 and characters displayed thereon. The reflectorized material shall  
13 be of such a nature as to provide effective and dependable  
14 brightness during the service period for which the license plate or  
15 decal is issued;

16 4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Tax  
17 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for all  
18 state vehicles. Such license plates shall be permanent in nature  
19 and designed in such manner as to remain with the vehicle for the  
20 duration of the vehicle's life span or until the title is  
21 transferred to a nongovernmental owner;

22 5. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Tax  
23 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for  
24 vehicles of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plates shall

1 have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain the letters "OHP"  
2 followed by the state seal and the badge number of the Highway  
3 Patrol officer to whom the vehicle is assigned. The words "Oklahoma  
4 Highway Patrol" shall also be included on such license plates;

5 6. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Tax  
6 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for  
7 vehicles of the Oklahoma Military Department. Such license plates  
8 shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall contain the letters  
9 "OMD" followed by the state seal and three numbers or letters as  
10 designated by the Adjutant General. The words "Oklahoma Military  
11 Department" shall also be included on such license plates; ~~and~~

12 7. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Tax  
13 Commission shall design appropriate official license plates for  
14 vehicles of the Oklahoma Department of Corrections. Such license  
15 plates shall contain the letters "DOC" followed by the Department of  
16 Corrections badge and three numbers or letters or combination of  
17 both as designated by the Director of the agency. The words  
18 "Department of Corrections" shall also be included on such license  
19 plates; and

20 8. Within the limits prescribed in this section, the Oklahoma  
21 Tourism and Recreation Department shall design any license plates  
22 required by the initiation of a license plate reissuance by the  
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission at the request of the Department of Public  
24 Safety pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act. Any



1 such new designs shall be submitted by the Oklahoma Tourism and  
2 Recreation Department to the Department of Public Safety for its  
3 approval prior to being issued by the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

4 C. Where the applicant has satisfactorily shown that the  
5 applicant owns the vehicle sought to be registered but is unable to  
6 produce documentary evidence of the ownership, a license plate may  
7 be issued upon approval by the Tax Commission or Corporation  
8 Commission, as applicable. In such instances the reason for not  
9 issuing a certificate of title shall be indicated on the receipt  
10 given to the applicant. It shall still be the duty of the applicant  
11 to immediately take all necessary steps to obtain the Oklahoma  
12 certificate of title and it shall be unlawful for the applicant to  
13 sell the vehicle until the certificate has been obtained in the  
14 applicant's name.

15 D. The certificate of registration provided for in this section  
16 shall be in convenient form, and the certificate of registration, or  
17 a certified copy or photostatic copy thereof, duly authenticated by  
18 the Tax Commission or Corporation Commission, as applicable, shall  
19 be carried at all times in or upon commercial vehicles so  
20 registered, in such manner as to permit a ready examination thereof  
21 upon demand by any peace officer of the state or duly authorized  
22 employee of the Department of Public Safety. Any such officer or  
23 agent may seize and hold such commercial vehicle when the operator  
24 of the same does not have the registration certificate in the

1 operator's possession or when any such officer or agent determines  
2 that the registration certificate has been obtained by  
3 misrepresentation of any essential or material fact or when any  
4 number or identifying information appearing on such certificate has  
5 been changed, altered, obliterated or concealed in any way, until  
6 the proper registration or identification of such vehicle has been  
7 made or produced by the owner thereof.

8 E. The purchaser of a new or used manufactured home shall,  
9 within thirty (30) days of the date of purchase, register the home  
10 with the Tax Commission or a motor license agent pursuant to the  
11 provisions of Section 1117 of this title. For a new manufactured  
12 home, it shall be the responsibility of the dealer selling the home  
13 to place a temporary license plate on the home in the same manner as  
14 provided in Section 1128 of this title for other new motor vehicles.  
15 For the first year that any manufactured home is registered in this  
16 state, the Tax Commission shall issue a metal license plate which  
17 shall be affixed to the manufactured home. The temporary dealer  
18 license plate or the metal license plate shall be displayed on the  
19 manufactured home at all times when upon a public roadway; provided,  
20 a repossession affidavit issued pursuant to Sections 1110 and 1126  
21 of this title shall be permissible in lieu of a current license  
22 plate and decal for the purposes of removing a repossessed  
23 manufactured home to a secure location. Manufactured homes  
24 previously registered and subject to ad valorem taxation as provided

1 by law shall have a decal affixed at the time ad valorem taxes are  
2 paid for such manufactured home; provided, for a manufactured home  
3 permanently affixed to real estate, no decal or license plate shall  
4 be required to be affixed and the owner thereof shall be given a  
5 receipt upon payment of ad valorem taxes due on the home. The Tax  
6 Commission shall make sufficient plates and decals available to the  
7 various motor license agents of the state in order for an owner of a  
8 manufactured home to acquire the plate or decal. A one-dollar fee  
9 shall be charged for issuance of any plate or decal. The fee shall  
10 be apportioned each month to the General Revenue Fund of the State  
11 Treasury.

12 F. The decal shall be easily visible for purposes of  
13 verification by a county assessor that the manufactured home is  
14 properly assessed for ad valorem taxation. In the first year of  
15 registration, a decal shall be issued for placement on the license  
16 plate indicating payment of applicable registration fees and excise  
17 taxes. A duplicate manufactured home registration decal shall be  
18 affixed inside the window nearest the front door of the manufactured  
19 home. In the second and all subsequent years for which the  
20 manufactured home is subject to ad valorem taxation, an annual decal  
21 shall be affixed inside the window nearest the front door as  
22 evidence of payment of ad valorem taxes. The Tax Commission shall  
23 issue decals to the various county treasurers of the state in order  
24 for a manufactured home owner to obtain such decal each year. Upon

1 presentation of a valid ad valorem tax receipt, the manufactured  
2 home owner shall be issued the annual decal.

3 G. Upon the registration of a manufactured home in this state  
4 for the first time or upon discovery of a manufactured home  
5 previously registered within this state for which the information  
6 required by this subsection is not known, the Tax Commission shall  
7 obtain:

8 1. The name of the owner of the manufactured home;

9 2. The serial number or identification number of the  
10 manufactured home;

11 3. A legal description or address of the location for the home;

12 4. The actual retail selling price of the manufactured home  
13 excluding Oklahoma taxes;

14 5. The certificate of title number for the home; and

15 6. Any other information which the Tax Commission deems to be  
16 necessary.

17 The application for registration shall also include the school  
18 district in which the manufactured home is located or is to be  
19 located. The information shall be entered into a computer data  
20 system which shall be used by the Tax Commission to provide  
21 information to county assessors upon request by the assessor. The  
22 assessor may request any information from the system in order to  
23 properly assess a manufactured home for ad valorem taxation.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
2 last amended by Section 23, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp.  
3 2016, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.3. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
7 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
8 subject as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
13 registered for the current year.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
15 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
16 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
17 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
18 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
19 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
20 issued on a staggered system.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license  
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special  
18 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special  
19 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission  
20 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications  
21 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax  
22 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective  
23 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null  
24 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time  
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
4 follows:

5 1. Round and Square Dance License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate  
7 support for round and square dancing;

8 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People  
9 License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the  
10 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and  
11 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

12 3. National Rifle Association License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
13 plates shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to  
14 the Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to  
15 any person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle  
16 Association;

17 4. Masonic Fraternity License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall  
18 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member  
19 of a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a  
20 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic  
22 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for  
23 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the  
24 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall  
2 contain the Masonic emblem;

3 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License  
4 ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support  
5 for Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall  
6 be issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a  
7 Shriner's Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed  
8 in consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall  
9 contain the Shriner's emblem;

10 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed  
11 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air  
12 ballooning in this state;

13 7. Order of the Eastern Star License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
14 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a  
15 member of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for  
16 an Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a  
17 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an  
18 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an  
19 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate  
20 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate  
21 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star  
22 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

23 8. Knights of Columbus License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall  
24 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member



1 of the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of  
2 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus  
4 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights  
5 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the  
6 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation  
7 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of  
8 Columbus emblem;

9 9. Jaycees License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be designed  
10 and issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such  
11 license plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The  
12 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

13 ~~10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be~~  
14 ~~designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for~~  
15 ~~Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed in~~  
16 ~~consultation with Ducks Unlimited;~~

17 ~~11.~~ Kiwanis International License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates  
18 shall be designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International.  
19 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of  
20 membership in Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be  
21 designed in consultation with Kiwanis International;

22 ~~12.~~ 11. Certified Public Accountants License ~~Plates~~ Plate -  
23 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this  
24 state who is a Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply

1 for a Certified Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle  
2 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of  
3 status as a Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall  
4 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified  
5 Public Accountants;

6 ~~13.~~ 12. Civil Emergency Management License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
7 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to  
8 demonstrate support for the state civil emergency management system.  
9 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of official  
10 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,  
11 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or  
12 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state  
13 emergency management department head;

14 ~~14.~~ 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such  
15 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the  
16 Tax Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and  
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian  
18 Conservation Corps;

19 ~~15.~~ 14. Rotarian License ~~Plates~~ Plate - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of  
21 a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian  
22 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
23 (1) ton or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the

11 to special license plates; correcting certain

16 design of license plates; authorizing certain

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as  
21 last amended by Section 23, Chapter 210, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp.  
22 2016, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
24 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or  
membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other  
subject as provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be

16 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
17 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
18 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide  
19 financial assistance as provided by this section.

20 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
21 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
22 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
23 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
24 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
7 issued on a staggered system.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for  
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for  
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the  
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates  
21 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,  
22 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of  
23 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special  
24 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration  
2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be  
3 removed from the vehicle.

4 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,  
5 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax  
6 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid  
7 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by  
8 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the  
9 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall  
10 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are

17 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an  
18 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.  
19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of  
20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any  
22 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may  
23 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated  
24 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon

13 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in  
14 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in  
15 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may  
16 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license  
17 plates.

19 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of

22 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the  
23 Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for  
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected  
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

7 wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic  
8 Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
