AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 35e, as 14 amended by Section 1, Chapter 172, O.S.L. 2013 (70 O.S. Supp. 2014, 15 Section 35e), is amended to read as follows: 16 Section 35e. A. It shall be the duty of the superintendent, 17 principal or head teacher of each public or private middle, junior 18 high and high school accredited by the State Department of Education 19 in the State of Oklahoma to notify the State Department of Education 20 quarterly as scheduled by the Department of the name, address, race 21 and age of any pupil dropping out from the school during the 22 preceding quarter. The report shall be made on forms prescribed and 23 furnished by the State Department of Education.

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- B. The State Board of Education shall cause these statistics of school dropouts to be tabulated by grade and school district.

 Information of school dropouts, including the name, address, race and age of any school dropout, shall be made available to the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma for use in the youth educational programs provided by the Department, and the State Department of Health.
 - C. The State Department of Education shall make an annual report to the Legislature prior to the convening of each regular session thereof of information received and tabulated pursuant to this section.
 - D. For the purposes of this section, school dropout means any student who is under the age of nineteen (19) and has not graduated from high school and is not attending any public or private school or is otherwise receiving an education pursuant to law for the full term the schools of the school district in which the student resides are in session.
 - SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
