L 6	defined by Section 1 of Article III of the Oklahoma Constitution		
L7	shall be entitled to become a registered voter in the precinct of		
L8	his or her residence, with the following conditions:		
L 9	1. Persons convicted of a felony shall be eligible to register

8	2. Any person who has been adjudged to be an incapacitated		
9	person as such term is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the

11	such incapacitated person has been adjudged to be no longer		
12	incapacitated such person shall be eligible to become a registered		
13	voter. The provisions of this paragraph shall not prohibit any		
14	person adjudged to be a partially incapacitated person as such term		
15	is defined by Section 1-111 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes		
16	from being eligible to register to vote unless the order adjudging		
17	the person to be partially incapacitated restricts such person from		
18	being eligible to register to vote.
