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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-1201, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1-1201. (a) A. It shall be unlawful for any person to
17	operate or maintain a hotel unless he <u>or she</u> shall have first
18	obtained, and holds, a license issued for such purpose by the State
19	Commissioner of Health. Unless otherwise provided by rule by the
20	State Board of Health Commissioner, each such license shall expire
21	on the 30th day of June next following its issuance, and the
22	Commissioner shall charge and collect therefor an annual fee to be
23	fixed by the Board of Health Commissioner. The term "hotel" as used
24	in this section shall mean and include any hotel, motel, tourist

1 court, apartment house, rooming house, or other place where sleeping 2 accommodations are furnished, or offered, for pay for transient 3 guests, if <u>four seven</u> or more rooms are available therein for 4 transient guests. This section shall apply to the operation of a 5 hotel by a state board.

6 The State Board of Health Commissioner may adopt <del>(b)</del> B. 7 reasonable standards, rules and regulations for hotels as to the 8 following: buildings and appurtenances thereto, including plumbing, 9 ventilation and lighting; construction, cleanliness and bactericidal 10 treatment of equipment and utensils; cleanliness and hygiene of 11 personnel; toilet facilities; disposal of wastes; water supply; and 12 any other items deemed necessary to safeguard the health, comfort 13 and safety of guests accommodated therein.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
