Any person who shall contemptuously or 16 maliciously tear down, burn, trample upon, mutilate, deface, defile, 17 defy, treat with indignity, wantonly destroy, or cast contempt, 18 either by word or act, upon any flag, standard, colors or ensign of 19 the United States of America, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a 20 felony. 21 Any person who shall burn in public any flag of the United 22 States of America with the intent to cause a breach of the peace or 23 incitement to riot shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony. A 24 person seeking to burn the United States flag must obtain a permit

1	from the proper city or county authority before proceeding and must
2	burn the flag in a safe and proper manner.
3	C. The word "defile" as used in this section shall include
4	public conduct which brings shame or disgrace upon any flag of the
5	United States by its use for unpatriotic or profane purpose.
6	C. D. The terms "flag", "standard", "colors", or "ensign" of
7	the United States as used in this section shall include any picture,
8	representation or part thereof which an average person would
9	believe, upon seeing and without deliberation, to represent the
10	flag, standard, colors or ensign of the United States of America.
11	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
