4 C. As authorized by the Uniform Time Act of 1966, as amended,
5 and notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary by
6 the United States government relating to adoption of daylight saving
7 time by all of the states, the State of Oklahoma elects to reject
8 such time and elects to continue in force the terms of subsection A
9 of this section relating to standard time in Oklahoma.

10 D. The rejection of daylight saving time as provided for in
11 this section may be changed by future legislative action.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
