16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 2807.1, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 2807.1. A. For purposes of the exemption authorized
19	pursuant to subsection B of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma
20	Constitution, "livestock employed in support of the family" means
21	all horses, cattle, mules, asses, sheep, swine, goats, poultry, and
22	any other livestock.
23	B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, for <u>For</u>
24	purposes of the exemption authorized pursuant to subsection B of

1	Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, and for
2	purposes of this section, livestock owned by a general partnership,
3	limited partnership, corporation, limited liability company, estate,
4	trust, or other lawfully recognized entity including animals owned
5	wholly or in part by a resident of a state other than this state and
6	a corporation incorporated in a state other than this state, shall
7	be deemed to be livestock employed in support of the family $ au$
8	provided at least fifty percent (50%) of the owners of the entity
9	shall be residents of this state to qualify for the exemption.
10	C. Animals owned wholly or in part by a publicly traded
11	corporation or a corporation incorporated in a state other than this
12	state shall not qualify for the exemption authorized pursuant to
13	subsection B of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution
14	as livestock employed in support of the family.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2023.
