A new section of law to be codified NEW LAW 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212A-3 of Title 74, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 For each appropriated executive branch agency having total 22 General Revenue Fund appropriations for a fiscal year which rank the 23 agency in the highest twenty such agencies for that fiscal year, the 24 State Auditor and Inspector shall conduct a comprehensive

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performance audit of any such agency if the chief executive officer
of the agency concludes his or her term of office, dies, resigns
from office, is removed from office or otherwise ends his or her
elected or appointed term of office.

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- B. As used in subsection A of this section, "performance audit" means an audit of a program, activity or function of a state agency conducted in accordance with applicable Government Auditing Standards. The term includes, but is not limited to, an audit to assess program, activity or function effectiveness, economy and efficiency, internal control, or compliance.
- 11 C. The expense of the audit shall be paid from the funds of the 12 audited agency.
 - D. The audit shall be completed not later than six (6) months after the audit begins.
 - E. The chief executive officer of the agency shall be required to implement the recommendations of the audit in order to ensure the agency is complying with constitutional and statutory mandates.
 - F. Upon completion of the audit, a copy of the audit shall be transmitted to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate.
 - G. Fifteen copies of the audit shall also be transmitted to the chairs of the House Appropriations and Budget Committee and the Senate Appropriations Committee.

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H. The committees identified in subsection G of this section
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    may hold special hearings regarding the audit and any issues or
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    exceptions contained in the audit findings.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
