7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalties; defining
9 term; providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 650.12 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Every person who, without justifiable or excusable cause and
16 with intent to do bodily harm, commits any assault, battery or
17 assault and battery upon the person of a municipal code enforcement
18 officer who is performing municipal code enforcement duties, upon
19 conviction, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the
20 custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding
21 two (2) years, or by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars
22 (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

1 B. As used in this section, "municipal code enforcement
2 officer" means any designated municipal employee or agent whose duty
3 it is to enforce codes and ordinances enacted by a municipality.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
