It shall be the duty of every railroad company or 18 corporation doing business, or operating a line of railroad, within 19 this state, to construct a crossing, limited to the space between 20 the tracks and two (2) feet on either side thereof, across that 21 portion of its track, roadbed or right-of-way over which any public 22 highway may run, and; to maintain the same that crossing 23 unobstructed, and in a good condition for the use of the public; 24 and to build and maintain in good condition all bridges and culverts

1 that may be necessary on its right-of-way at such crossing and in 2 case any railroad company or corporation fails so to construct and maintain said crossing for thirty (30) days after written notice by 3 4 the road overseer of any road district or the council or board of 5 trustees of any city or town in this state, or fifty (50) 6 petitioners of any city or town who are interested (where such work 7 or repairs are needed), to be given to the section boss, or any 8 station agent of any railroad company or corporation in the county 9 (where such work or repairs are needed) it shall forfeit and pay to 10 said county, road district, city or town complaining, the sum of 11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for every day said company or 12 corporation may neglect to comply with the requirements of this 1.3 section. 14 SECTION 2.
