6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to workforce development funding;
8 providing for allocation of funds through the
9 Taxpayer Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
10 program; providing for priority of allocation based
11 on certain workforce development programs; providing
12 for codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9101 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any federal funds allocated to a state agency as part of the
18 Taxpayer Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program for purposes
19 of workforce development shall be used for workforce development
20 programs that support the short-term training of workers in sectors
21 with high demand. The allocation shall take into consideration the
22 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act and give priority to
23 programs implemented in both major metropolitan areas and other
24 areas of the state through local workforce development boards.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
