7	An Act relating to labor; creating the Voluntary

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801 of Title 40, unless there is
17	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Voluntary
19	Veterans' Preference Employment Policy Act".
20	B. As used in this section:
21	1. "DD 214" means a Department of Defense Report of Separation
22	form or its predecessor or successor forms;
23	2. "Private employer" means a sole proprietor, corporation,

partnership, limited liability company or other entity with one (1)

- or more employees. It does not include the state or a political subdivision of the state such as a municipality, county, township or school district;
 - 3. "Veteran" means a person who served on active duty in the Armed Forces and was discharged or released with an honorable discharge; and
 - 4. "Veterans' preference employment policy" means a private employer's voluntary preference for hiring, promoting or retaining a veteran over another qualified applicant or employee.
 - C. A private employer may have a voluntary veterans' preference employment policy. The veterans' preference employment policy shall be:
 - 1. In writing; and
 - 2. Applied uniformly to employment decisions regarding hiring, promotion or retention during a reduction in force.
 - D. An employer may require that a veteran submit a DD 214 to a private employer with a veterans' preference employment policy to be eligible for the preference.
- E. Granting preference pursuant to this section does not violate any local or state equal employment opportunity law, including, but not limited to, Article 3, Chapter 21 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
