11	An Act relating to labor; creating the Voluntary
12	Veterans' Preference Employment Policy Act; defining terms; authorizing employer to have a voluntary

14	certain preferences does not violate certain laws; requiring Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs to
15	provide certain assistance; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801 of Title 40, unless there is
21	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Voluntary
23	Veterans' Preference Employment Policy Act".
24	B. As used in this section:

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<u>UNDERLINED</u> language denotes Amendments to present Statutes. BOLD FACE CAPITALIZED language denotes Committee Amendments. Strike thru language denotes deletion from present Statutes. 1. "Private employer" means a sole proprietor, corporation,
 2 partnership, limited liability company or other entity with one (1)
 3 or more employees. It does not include the state or a political
 4 subdivision of the state such as a municipality, county, township or
 5 school district;

6 2. "Veteran" means a person who served on active duty in the
7 Armed Forces and was discharged or released with an honorable
8 discharge; and

9 3. "Veterans' preference employment policy" means a private
10 employer's voluntary preference for hiring, promoting or retaining a
11 veteran over another gualified applicant or employee.

12 C. A private employer may have a voluntary veterans' preference 13 employment policy. The veterans' preference employment policy shall 14 be:

15 1. In writing; and

Applied uniformly to employment decisions regarding hiring,
 promotion or retention during a reduction in force.

D. Granting preference pursuant to this section does not
violate any local or state equal employment opportunity law,
including, but not limited to, Article 3, Chapter 21 of Title 25 of
the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. The Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs shall assist a
private employer in determining if an applicant is a veteran in a
manner that protects personal privacy.
