L 6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801 of Title 40, unless there is

L 9	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Voluntary
20	Veterans' Preference Employment Policy Act".
21	B. As used in this section:
22	1. "Private employer" means a sole proprietor, corporation,
23	partnership, limited liability company or other entity with one or

more employees. It does not include the state or a political

- subdivision of the state such as a municipality, county, township or school district;
- 2. "Veteran" means a person who served on active duty in the

 Armed Forces of the United States and was discharged or released

 with an honorable discharge; and
 - 3. "Veterans' preference employment policy" means a private employer's voluntary preference for hiring, promoting or retaining a veteran over another qualified applicant or employee.
- 9 C. A private employer may have a voluntary veterans' preference 10 employment policy. The veterans' preference employment policy shall 11 be:
- 12 | 1. In writing; and
- 2. Applied uniformly to employment decisions regarding hiring, promotion or retention during a reduction-in-force.
 - D. Granting preference pursuant to this section does not violate any local or state equal employment opportunity law, including, but not limited to, Article 3, Chapter 21 of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- E. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall assist a private employer in determining if an applicant is a veteran in a manner that protects personal privacy.
